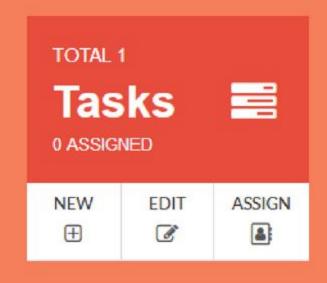
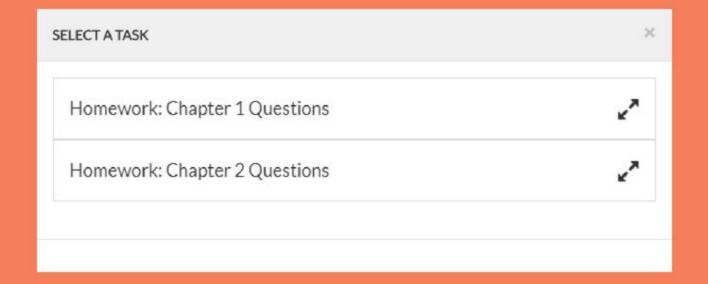
ASSIGNING A TASK

4. SELECT ASSIGNEES

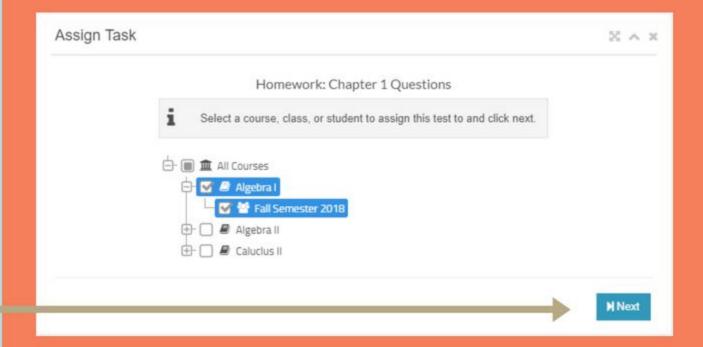


5. CLICK 'NEXT' BUTTON

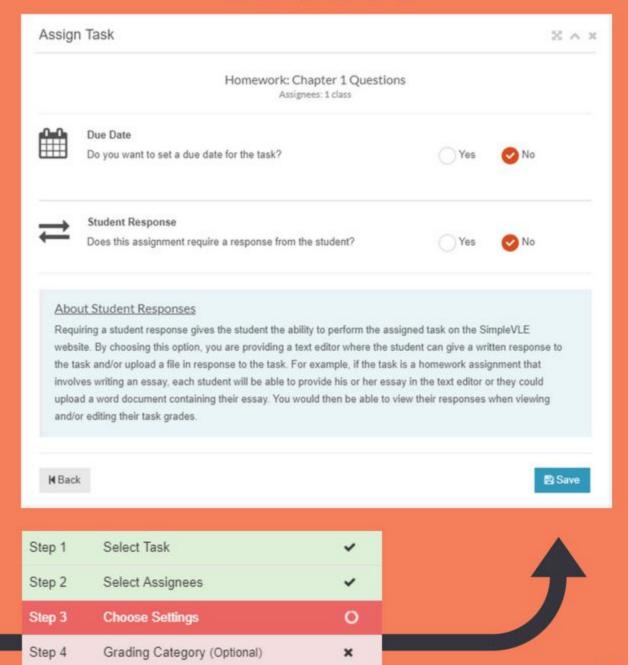


6. SELECT DUE DATE IF NECCESSARY

8. CLICK 'SAVE' BUTTON



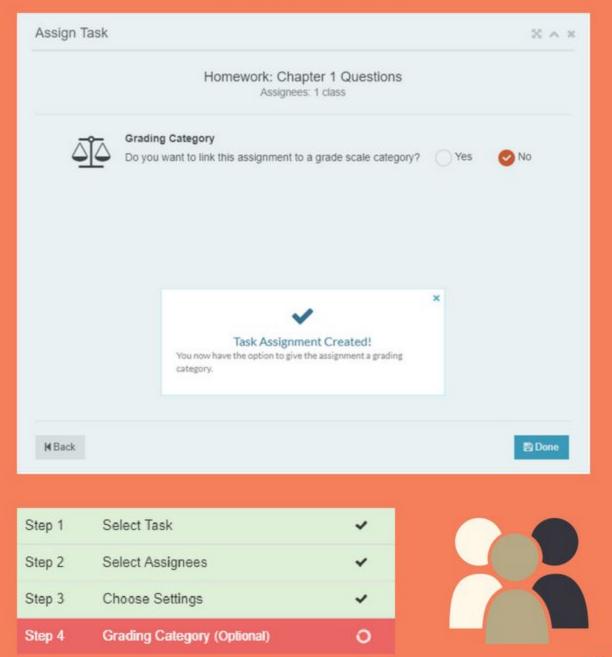

THE PROGRESS STEP TABLE INDICATES WHAT STEP YOUR ON





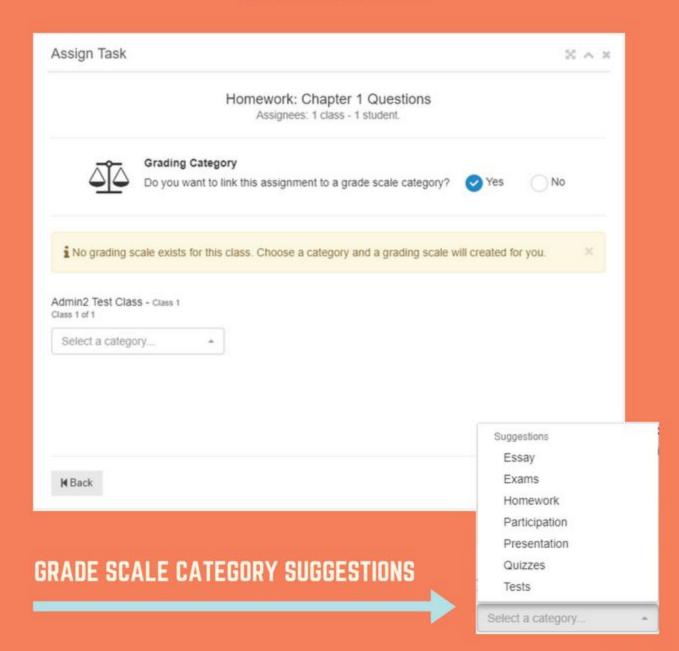


9. SELECT A GRADING CATEGORY IF APPLICABLE

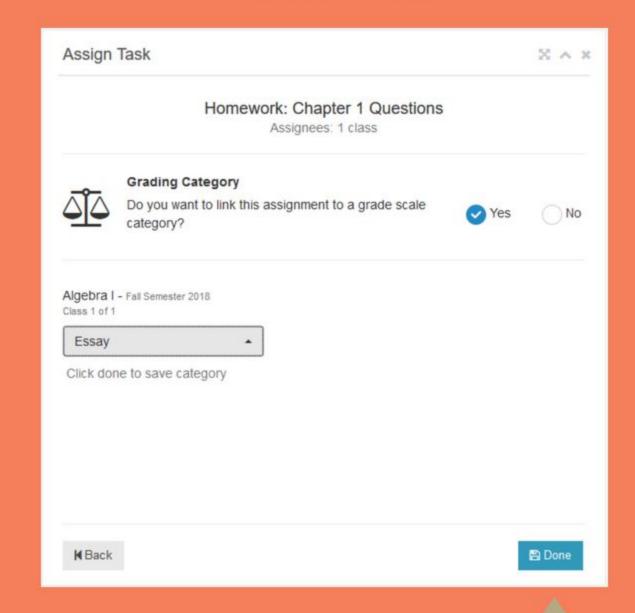

EXISTING GRADE SCALE

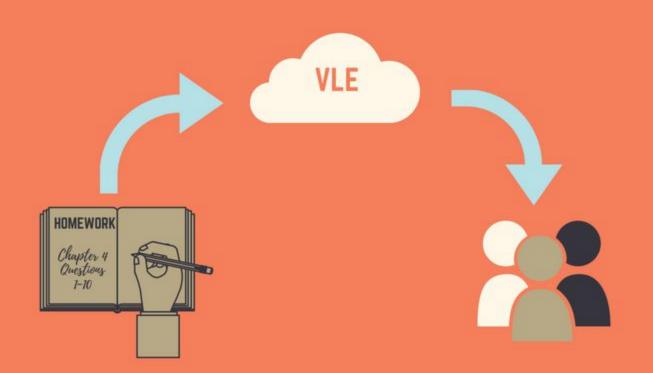
In this example, a grading scale has already been created.
Therefore, the assignment only has to be linked to the correct grading category.

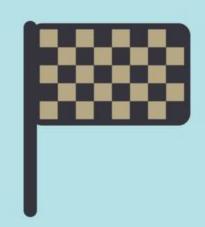
