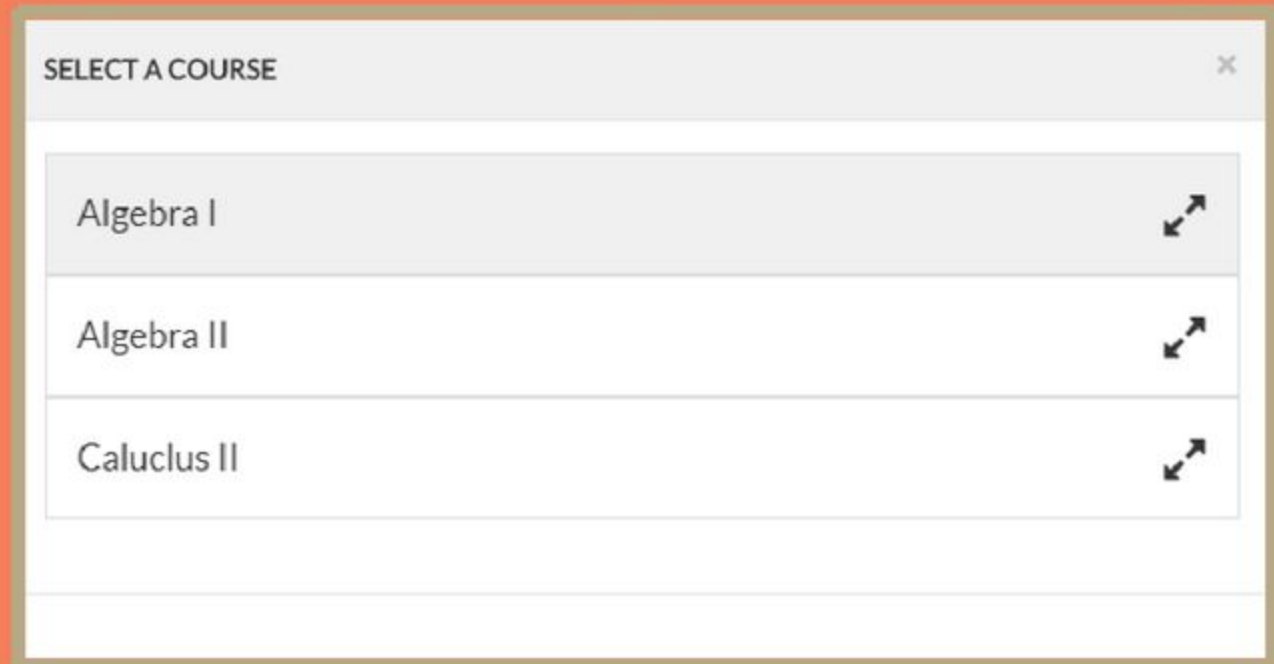
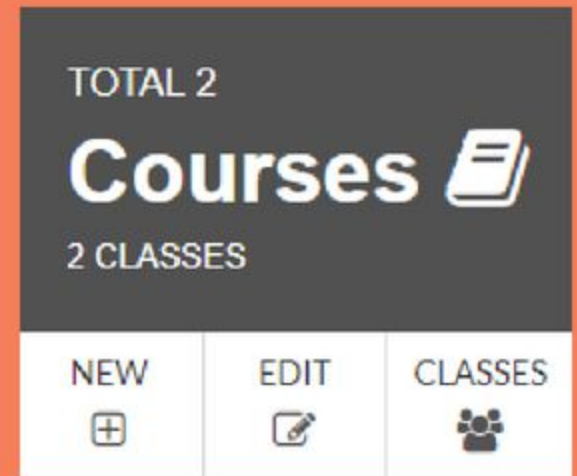


CREATING A CLASS

3. SELECT A COURSE



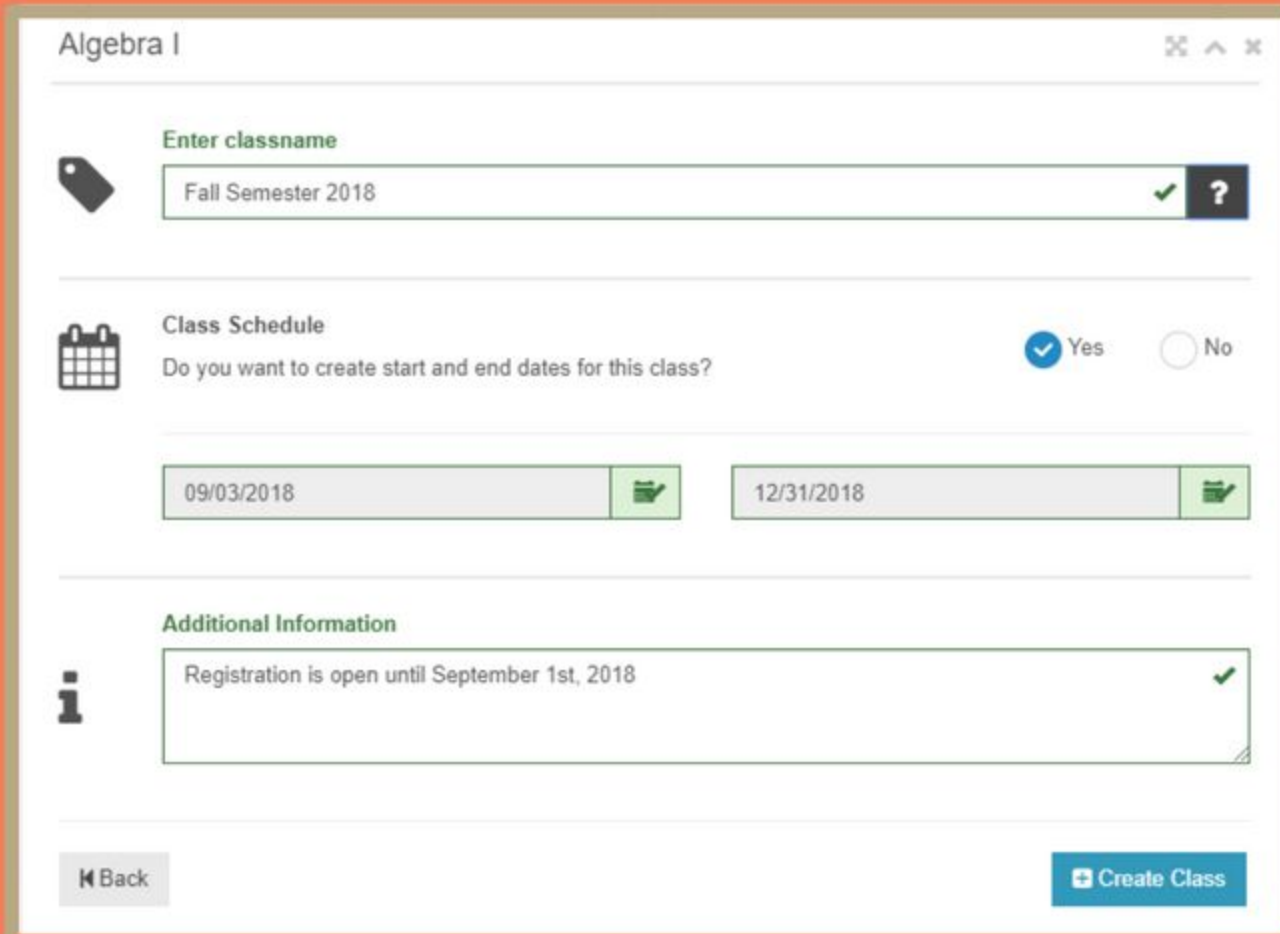

CLASS SETTINGS

EDIT STUDENTS

This option gives the instructor the ability to manually create student accounts as well as edit existing ones in that class.

STUDENT VIEW

Allows the instructor to view the class from a student's perspective. Provides the ability to customize the class by sorting assignments and announcements as well as inserting pictures and other visual effects.

CLASS SETTINGS
