
## CREATING A TASK

A task could be just about anything other than a test. Homework, essays, lessons, or tutorials. When assigned, they can be graded or not.




### 1. CLICK NEW



#### 2. ENTER TASK NAME



Using the CKEditor, you can design rich content that include pictures, embedded videos, and much more. You can paste from word documents or format your text from scratch.






#### 3. CREATE CONTENT

#### 4. UPLOAD FILES

There are no limits on file size or number of files you can upload if you have a premium account. You can upload 3 files under 5mb per assignment with a free account.






5. CLICK ADD FILES

After browsing for the file you want to attach and selecting it, you will still need to start the upload. If you want to cancel, simply click the cancel button. Otherwise click start to begin the upload.






#### 8. CLICK START



After clicking start you will see a progress bar, upload speeds, and an upload time interval.






## 9. WAIT FOR UPLOAD TO FINISH








10. CLICK 'ADD FILES'




